Evaluating our programs is extremely important to our mission at the Kansas Learning Center for Health. Ongoing assessment ensures we are delivering high quality programs to the students in Kansas. Using pre- and post-tests with students at the center and the teacher evaluations help us quantify the impact we're making.

During the 2007-2008 school year, student's demonstrated considerable knowledge gained in outcomes-based tests that were performed in three program areas: general health, growth and development and drug prevention.

Teachers at the Learning Center play an important role in shaping the programs and services delivered to Kansas students. Following each program, each teacher or parent is asked to provide feedback on program content, instructor knowledge, curriculum requirements and student involvement. More than 96% of teachers rated our programs "Excellent."
